

## Everything Around Registration, Wait List, Enrolment Fees and Changes

<b>Enrolment Fee:</b>	Single Entry: 20 Euros (advance payment until 11.09.2022); 30 Euros (after 11.09.2022 or on site) Double Entry: 38 Euros (advance payment until 11.09.2022); 60 Euros (after 11.09.2022 or on site)
<b>Registration:</b>	Registration is only possible via the enrolment tool on <a href="http://www.adlercups.com">www.adlercups.com</a> (English version available). No registrations via email! Registrations are binding!
<b>Enrolment Tool:</b>	The new enrolment tool demands a registration of your club or association first. Upon that, participants can be added and/or changed. Please only enrol your club/association once. The enrolment tool is available in English and German.
<b>Changes:</b>	Changes can be done <u>free of charge until 11.09.2022</u> (registration deadline) within the tool. <b>EXCEPTION:</b> Changes of the age group/gender will cancel the guaranteed entry ticket. Upon registration deadline all changes (including those made on site) are 25 Euro per participant. This includes changes of name, e.g. mixed up first and last names. So please register carefully!
<b>Wait List / Choice System:</b>	Our aim is a balanced and international judo youth tournament. As of that, we have decided to only allow 50% of all participants to receive guaranteed entries upon enrolment. Upon reaching these 50%, we will appoint entry tickets on a case-by-case basis with above aim in mind (criteria based). Such decisions of ours are solely our call and final. We try our best to make fair decisions.
<b>Confirmation upon Payment:</b>	<b>Registrations will only be finally confirmed upon payment of the enrolment fees within 6 weeks. Non paid enrolments will be put on a wait list after 6 weeks (and the guaranteed entry ticket(s) is lost). The same principle applies to confirmations (by us) of wait list positions: if not paid within 6 weeks, the entry ticket will be granted to a different athlete.</b> <b>! Please make the wire transfer immediately upon enrolment and received confirmation !</b>
<b>Cancellations:</b>	Cancellations of participants lead to a loss of the guaranteed entry ticket (and someone else will be granted the entry ticket). Enrolment fees are non-refundable. Until the registration deadline, all changes of participants are free of charge - and paid enrolment fees are not lost. Change of age group is also free of charge, but the guaranteed entry ticket may be lost. If in such case, the participant does not receive an entry ticket, the enrolment fee is lost. Enrolment fees are never paid back. A start to the tournament is only possible, after having paid <u>ALL</u> due enrolment fees before the start of the tournament, including cancellations.

### Covid-19 Security & Regulation

#### At Adler Cup 2022 we might have to enforce 2G+

To access Adler Cup it may be still or again mandatory to provide the following documents:

A proof of the complete course of vaccinations, under the then enacted legal definition(s), using vaccines approved by the European Medicines Agency (EMA) or PEI, whereas the last vaccination might not be older than 3 months or already 3 vaccinations („booster“) or 4 („super booster“) can be proved or proof of „recent“ recovery

AND / OR (possibly)

receive a negative Covid-19 test result from an on-site test center that would be operated free of charge for the participant.

All Adler Cup visitors might have to abide by the then existing distance and hygiene regulations. **Statutory requirements must be enforced by us and might be an integral part of a special permission to conduct the Adler Cup under then current conditions.** Each visitor of Adler Cup should regularly look up current Covid-19 rules and regulation on the Adler Cup webpage and make sure to be prepared for any upon arrival.

Despite all measures we put in place to mitigate health risks, we cannot eliminate the risk of infection to zero. This said, everyone visiting Adler Cup does so totally at the individual's risk and neither the Adler Cup nor any representative are liable for any health risk by any means.

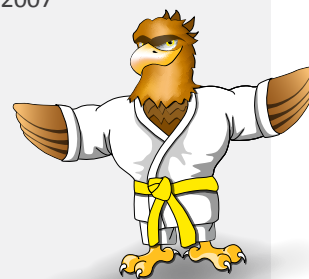

<b>Contest Area:</b>	8 tatamis (competition areas) with a minimum of 6 x 6 m contest area
<b>Participants:</b>	Admissible are club members of DJB, EJU, IJF, born 2002 - 2013, min. 7th Kyu with valid Judo Passport, verified at weigh in. Participants must provide their white/red belts.
<b>Duration:</b>	U13 / U16 m/f: 3 minutes, U18 / U21 m/f: 4 minutes
<b>Awards/Medals:</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- 1st - 3rd places receive the Olympic Style Adler Cup medal</li> <li>- Every contestant receives a certificate of participation (from 5th place on demand)</li> <li>- The best club team throughout the tournament (both days) receives the Adler Cup Trophy (<i>team valuation based on points: 1. = 7 pt., 2. = 4 pt., 3. = 2 pt., 5. = 1 pt.</i>)</li> <li>- 🏆 Special Talent Award with 500 Euro Prize Money for an outstanding athlete</li> </ul>
